CHILDREN'S MINISTRY Gr. 1-5

I am very happy to say that as I write this we are open to "In Person" learning for ALL Children's Ministry. Sunday school for grades 1-5 are meeting in the Peace Center from 9:30-10:15. Safety precautions are in place including wearing a mask, social distancing, and sanitizing. To relieve the pressure on numbers Sunday morning, we have added a Wednesday Sunday school option. Cancellations - Due to COVID

- Dorcas Meeting has been canceled thru February.

Peace staff is working hard to provide a safe place to gather and worship.

- The custodians are constantly wiping the frequently touched surfaces including the pews between services.
- Face masks and hand sanitizers are available throughout the building for everyone's use.
- Bible study participants and meeting attendees are helping by wiping down the tables after the meeting to ensure a clean surface for the next group.
- The furnace and air handling system uses HEPA filters that are replaced regularly to keep the air as fresh as possible.
- Work has recently been done to improve the air exchange/air flow more efficiently.
- Parish Health has provided a misting device to cover large surfaces like Little Lambs Christian Center, Kitchens, bathrooms and other areas with many surface areas. It is quick and provides cleaning in hard to reach places.

When this is all over, we look forward to being back to 'normal' but in the mean time please look at Peace as a safe place to be. We all do our part by wearing appropriate masks over our mouth and nose, washing our hands frequently and maintaining the 6 foot distance whenever possible.

MISSION & MINISTRY MINUTES - Wednesday, December 15, 2020

Call to Order: Bob

Present are: Bob Sylvester, Chuck Jones, Troy Puckett, Barb Otte, Kim Borka, Lynn Brown, Heidi Sickmann, Pastor Pasche, Shirley Uldbjerg, Coleen Dostal, Robbie Peterson

Opening Prayer: Bob opened with prayer and Philippians 4: 5-8 devotion reading.

Approval of Minutes: Motion to approve the Minutes from Nov 24 meeting was made by Troy, seconded by Kim. Motion is passed.

Motion to approve: Dec. 3 minutes made by Troy and seconded by Lynn with correction of adding Confession as a part of Reconciliation to Dr. Woodford's Dec. 3 Bible Study. Lynn will email the correction to Coleen. Motion is passed.

Motion to approve: Dec. 10 minutes with correction, (changing language of HR person to HR/ Minister of Operations person). Motion made by Lynn and seconded by Shirley. Motion is passed.

Motion was made by Barb that a copy of Dec. 10 minutes be made available to read in the office, and copies not made or taken home. Shirley seconded the motion, motion is passed.

Discussion of Oct. 8 Special meeting of elected leaders approved at Oct. 20 MMC meeting: Bob noted that when both Council and Elders are at a meeting, the minutes should also be sent to the Elders for approval. Coleen will take care of this. Bob also asked the minutes to be corrected to read.. "Jeff suggested outreach to the past Steering Committee also occur." in place of the statement, "Jeff will visit with the past Steering committee and update them."

Pastor's Report: Advent services will have a take-out lunch. Right now, nothing after Funerals or Weddings. Children's Christmas Program; a video is being made. Live streaming will be a big part of it. We are all adapting to distance learning. Confirmation will be distance learning after the first of the year. Dr. Dixon is working with AVE, fixing the problems caused by lightning. AVE will replace the last of the damage. Also, we are working on an upgrade to our internet system, a proposal is being put together.

Treasurer's Report: Troy sent out Treasurer's Report previously thru email and handed out 2021 Budget plans at meeting. He highlighted reports, budget vs. Jan -Nov. 2020 giving. December is usually a big month, but we are short on our giving. The good news is we haven't spent as much as most years.

Troy- I feel we should not pass a budget for anymore than we bring in. This year, with Covid makes it very hard to put together a budget, with less offerings than the year before. Budget was discussed.

Bob- Let's take this home, study it and we'll discuss and vote on it before the Voter's Meeting in January. Thank you Troy for all your hard work.

Bob invited Elder's Chairman, Robbie, to the meeting. Discussion of Elder's quarterly written report to be submitted to council according to the by-laws. John Lietz asked if Elder's terms could be staggered and 1 year terms/ 2 year terms. Nominating committee has been working on the ballot and agrees and has been discussing this at their meeting.

Unfinished Business- Debriefing with Link Report. Lynn made the Motion: Two from Link Team, along with Bob and Robbie to meet with Pastor Pasche to review Link Team report. Barb seconded it. Motion is passed. Jeff and Heidi will be the two from Link Team at the meeting.

Motion made by Troy: After Christmas and after Monday's meeting with Pastor Pasche, assemble a small committee to review Pastor's job description and Link Team responsibilities. Lynn seconded the motion. Motion is passed unanimously. Volunteers for sub-committee: Chuck and Lynn will be co-chairs with Kim and Pastor Pasche on the committee.

Annual Voter's Meeting will be Sunday, January 31, 2021. Lynn will figure out how to communicate to congregation info about Voter's meeting. Lynn will also review the resolution written by Paul Otte to help allow more people to participate than just those at the meeting. Discussion followed of items to be on Agenda at Voter's Meeting.

Motion made by Troy: Ballot voting in person at Voter's meeting with 3 available rooms to accommodate- the Sanctuary, The Peace Center and the Chapel, with expectations of social distancing and masks required. Motion was seconded by Heidi. Motion is carried.

Discussion of February council meeting to make appropriate provisions for our by-laws.

Discussion of staff Christmas cards, Barb made the motion to go ahead with Troy's suggestion. Coleen seconded motion. Motion is passed.

Meeting was closed with the Lord's Prayer.

Coleen made motion to adjourn the meeting. Barb seconded motion. Motion is passed.
