#### MISSION & MINISTRY MINUTES - Thursday, January 14, 2021 7 pm

Present: Troy Puckett, Pastor Pasche, Lynn Brown, Shirley Uldbjerg, Barb Otte, Kim Borka, Heidi Sickmann, Bob Sylvester, Chuck Jones Absent: Coleen Dostal

Bob called the meeting to order and opened with prayer.

Bob asked for motion to approve December 15, 2020 minutes. Heidi made a motion to approve, and Kim seconded with all voting aye.

Discussion ensued concerning whether Coleen would continue serving on Link Team as she has decided not to run for a second term as secretary. Coleen had shared with Heidi that she is willing to remain on the Link Team after her term expires. Council consensus was that it was best for staff continuity to keep her on the team. Troy made a motion to have Coleen remain on the Link Team, Chuck seconded it, with all voting aye.

**Treasurer's Report**: Troy reported that we ended the year 2020 in the black, only because expenses were down due to Covid. Giving did not meet projection and was down \$37,241. The proposed budget for 2021 includes a \$72,023 increase, mostly due to payroll. Payroll Protection Program (PPP) was applied for and approved for \$151,000. PLC met all standards for use of this money, so loan was forgiven on November 2, 2020. Balance of this fund, 146,601, will be allocated based upon decisions made by treasurer and mission and ministry council.

There is \$8,786 remaining in the prescription account. Assessment owed on 5th Street is \$5,644.

Additional financial report details are available in the church office. After lengthy discussion concerning staff pay increases and percentage of insurance premium costs paid by PLC and percentage paid by staff, Lynn made a motion to give raises of 1% across the board, Shirley, seconded, with all voting aye. Troy made a motion to keep insurance coverage at 80/20 coverage for insurance, and Barb seconded, with all voting aye.

Sub-committee formed (Lynn, Chuck, Pastor Pasche, Kim) to write job description for director of operations discussed progress and handed out draft job description. There was not consensus on number of hours needed to meet needs of the position. No decision was made as to next steps.

Lynn handed out ballot for annual voters' meeting scheduled for January 31, 2021. **Next meeting** is Tuesday, January 19, 2021 at 7:00 P.M. Meeting was adjourned. Lynn closed with prayer. Respectfully submitted,

#### Call to Order: Bob

**Treasurer's Report:** Troy shared what is going into the yearbook via passing out a sheet "2020 Annual Report." The congregation can request seeing the proposed budget for 2021 if they so wish.

Wages change as of February 1st of each year after the budget has been proposed at the annual Voter's Meeting. Discussion of presenting the budget to the congregation at the Annual Voter's Meeting for January 31, 2021 took place. Explanation will be shared for the need for Director of Operations and how it will be funded only one time from the Payroll Protection Program (PPP) monies. This expense is approximately \$65,000 for wages / benefits. At the Annual Meeting, it will be explained that in the 2021 budget, we will need to reassess that position and if it would continue to be needed. This would then become part of a line item in the budget. Troy will present an extra slide explaining this to the congregation at the meeting. This position will be defined as "Director of Operations." Troy shared that we do not qualify for a second round of PPP monies.

**Barb--** made a motion that when the new elected leaders come in, pictures and biographies get put up in the church. Barb withdrew the motion. A new motion was made by Chuck to create profiles for elected officials of Mission and Ministry and the Board of Elders to be posted in a common area of the church. This is to be completed by February 28, 2021. Barb seconded the motion with all voting aye.

**Next meeting:** February 16, 2021; 7:00 p.m. Meeting was adjourned at 8:20 p.m. Closed with Lord's Prayer Respectfully submitted,
