OLD TESTAMENT READING: Proverbs 8:1-4, 22-31

Does not wisdom call out?

Does not understanding raise her voice?

- ² At the highest point along the way, where the paths meet, she takes her stand;
- ³ beside the gate leading into the city, at the entrance, she cries aloud:
- ⁴ "To you, O people, I call out; I raise my voice to all mankind.
- ²² "The LORD brought me forth as the first of his works, before his deeds of old;
- ²³ I was formed long ages ago, at the very beginning, when the world came to be.

- ²⁴ When there were no watery depths, I was given birth, when there were no springs overflowing with water;
- ²⁵ before the mountains were settled in place, before the hills, I was given birth,
- ²⁶ before he made the world or its fields or any of the dust of the earth.
- ²⁷ I was there when he set the heavens in place, when he marked out the horizon on the face of the deep,
- ²⁸ when he established the clouds above and fixed securely the fountains of the deep,
- when he gave the sea its boundary so the waters would not overstep his command, and when he marked out the foundations of the earth.
- Then I was constantly at his side.
 I was filled with delight day after day, rejoicing always in his presence,
- ³¹ rejoicing in his whole world and delighting in mankind. (NIV)

NEW TESTAMENT READING: Acts 2:14a, 22-36

- ¹⁴ Then Peter stood up with the Eleven, raised his voice and addressed the crowd:
- ²² "Fellow Israelites, listen to this: Jesus of Nazareth was a man accredited by God to you by miracles, wonders and signs, which God did among you through him, as you yourselves know. ²³ This man was handed over to you by God's deliberate plan and foreknowledge; and you, with the help of wicked men, put him to death by nailing him to the cross. ²⁴ But God raised him from the dead, freeing him from the agony of death, because it was impossible for death to keep its hold on him. ²⁵ David said about him:

"'I saw the Lord always before me.

Because he is at my right hand, I will not be shaken.

- ²⁶ Therefore my heart is glad and my tongue rejoices; my body also will rest in hope,
- ²⁷ because you will not abandon me to the realm of the dead, you will not let your holy one see decay.
- ²⁸ You have made known to me the paths of life; you will fill me with joy in your presence.'
- ²⁹ "Fellow Israelites, I can tell you confidently that the patriarch David died and was buried, and his tomb is here to this day. ³⁰ But he was a prophet and knew that God had promised him on oath that he would place one of his descendants on his throne. ³¹ Seeing what was to come, he spoke of the resurrection of the Messiah, that he was not abandoned to the realm of the dead, nor did his body see decay. ³² God has raised this Jesus to life, and we are all witnesses of it. ³³ Exalted to the right hand of God, he has received from the Father the promised Holy Spirit and has poured out what you now see and hear. ³⁴ For David did not ascend to heaven, and yet he said,

"'The Lord said to my Lord:

"Sit at my right hand 35 until I make your enemies a footstool for your feet.""

³⁶ "Therefore let all Israel be assured of this: God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Messiah." (NIV)

⁴⁸ The Jews answered him, "Aren't we right in saying that you are a Samaritan and demon-possessed?"
⁴⁹ "I am not possessed by a demon," said Jesus, "but I honor my Father and you dishonor me. ⁵⁰ I am not seeking glory for myself; but there is one who seeks it, and he is the judge. ⁵¹ Very truly I tell you, whoever obeys my word will never see death."

⁵² At this they exclaimed, "Now we know that you are demon-possessed! Abraham died and so did the prophets, yet you say that whoever obeys your word will never taste death. ⁵³ Are you greater than our father Abraham? He died, and so did the prophets. Who do you think you are?"

⁵⁴ Jesus replied, "If I glorify myself, my glory means nothing. My Father, whom you claim as your God, is the one who glorifies me. ⁵⁵ Though you do not know him, I know him. If I said I did not, I would be a liar like you, but I do know him and obey his word. ⁵⁶ Your father Abraham rejoiced at the thought of seeing my day; he saw it and was glad."

⁵⁷ "You are not yet fifty years old," they said to him, "and you have seen Abraham!"

⁵⁸ "Very truly I tell you," Jesus answered, "before Abraham was born, I am!" ⁵⁹ At this, they picked up stones to stone him, but Jesus hid himself, slipping away from the temple grounds. (NIV)
