Churches there are often built with just the walls or thatched roofs that require constant maintenance and repair since the materials for a tin roof are too expensive. So far our offerings have purchased a tool box for a worker (with a hammer, saw and machete/axe) and a supply of nails. We are halfway toward our next goal of purchasing the wooden structures to support the roof! We are excited to see if, by the end of the school year, we can provide a dry and long-lasting place for God to come to His people in the Word and the Sacraments!
