Today we are blessing 133 baby kits (181 this year) and 18 quilts (80 this year) for **Lutheran World Relief.** We pray that these will be a great blessing and a message of love, hope and peace to those who receive them.

This week in **Sunday School**, the children see how God called Gideon to lead His chosen people against their Midianite enemies. God leads Gideon to reduce his army from 32,000 men to a mere 300. Reassured by the Lord, Gideon moves forward with God' improbable plan. Armed with only torches and trumpets, Gideon's mini army defeats the mighty Midianite force wiothout lifting a sword. In the same way, we trust God's love and provision for us, especially in providing for us a Savior, Jesus Christ. Read the whole account in Judges 7:1-23.

The **High School Bible Class** will be discussing "Future Potential." Thinking about the future can be intimidating for anyone. Young people especially may feel anxiety as they strive to balance pressing needs and face major decisions about college, career, family and future. But today we learn that God's plan is always to bless, to give the best possible results. We sin when we replace His goals for us with our own and when we seek to accomplish His goals through our own efforts. God promises complete forgiveness for these failures through faith in Jesus' sacrifice. By the power of the Holy Spirit working through Word and Sacraments, God enables our plans to be rooted in Him.
