This week's memory verse is "Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all His benefits, who forgives all your iniquity, who heals all your diseases, who redeems your life from the pit, who crown you with steadfast love and mercy." Three of the eight Elders seats will serve for one year, which will result in 5 open seats in the 2024 election, thereby putting the terms for Elders back into compliance with the Bylaws. The term limits required by the Bylaws will be dispensed with until the election cycle issue for the members of the Board of Elders has been resolved in 2024.
