## From the Desk of Senior Pastor Glenn Meyer, IIM

"I Am the true vine, and My Father is the gardener. He cuts off every branch in Me that bears no fruit, while every branch that does bear fruit, He prunes so that it will be even more fruitful. ... I Am the Vine; you are the branches. If a man remains in Me and I in him, he will bear much fruit; apart from Me you can do nothing. ... You did not choose Me, but I chose you and appointed you to go and bear fruit - fruit that will last." John 15 (selected verses)

I know about burning branches. At different times in my life as an amateur gardener, I have burned piles of trimmed tree branches, leaves, and gnarly vines from my garden. When the branches have been cut off from the vine and the trunk for quite some time, they have burned quickly.

Not so, the fires of hell. Those who cut themselves off from God's Word & Sacraments, and end up cutting themselves off from our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ will perish in Hell. And that is a fire of separation from God that will never end.

We live at a time when many people seem to want God, but they want Him according to their own image and standards. They want Him to approve and okay what they 'feel' and 'do' and if He won't, then they basically say, 'I don't need You'. But they do, we all do. We all need Jesus, every day and moment.

Apart from Jesus, we all would perish. In Jesus, we have life, true life. In Jesus, there is forgiveness and salvation offered to all even in the midst of our troubles and confusion. Trusting in Jesus and leaning on Him, we have the assurance of His strength, grace and power to keep us on the right path in times of blessing and to carry us in times of trial. And Yes, we have fellow Christians who are facing tough, tough trials. Our hearts go out to them and we must keep lifting them up to God in our prayers. We must do all we can to NOT add to their trials and burdens!

At our home in Wisconsin over 15 years ago, I had worked hard to put up special posts and wires for a grape vine 'trellis'. I then had four grape vines that had done very well, but the problem was that they kept growing out over our fence into our neighbor's bushes and small trees. (She was a dear neighbor but her yard was a jungle!) So I built something to help keep them on my side (the sunny side) of the fence and grow more in the full sun. It worked to perfection. The vines produced wonderful bunches of grapes that were easily harvested instead of being hidden in the midst of bushes where they were unproductive.

In a way, this is similar to what we try to do as a caring Christian church and family in Christ Jesus. We look to God's Word for instruction and guidance and put together the 'trellis' the paths and structures on which our children and others can grow and be productive. We help guide them according to God's Word so that they know the right path with God and do not stumble and struggle in the path that leads to destruction. We help them grow in the full 'Son-shine' of God's grace and mercy. We feed and nurture their faith and life with God's gifts of baptism and His
