Meeting #2 The second meeting will happen on Sunday, Dec 10th, following the 10:30 service. At this meeting the congregation will be asked to vote on the options that were discussed at the first meeting.

These are important meetings that need our prayerful thought and decision making. Please plan to attend both.

The Congregational Fund Committee has voted to match an additional \$50,000 towards the debt reduction initiative. This match will be of monies donated towards the principal from November 1 through December 31. We are on track to potentially decrease our principal balance by over \$500,000 for this calendar year! It is amazing the way our members have stepped up with this cause! We are truly blessed!
