DEBT REDUCTION UPDATE—As you can see, our principal balance is now down to \$1,646.266.72. Shortly we will receive the \$50,000 matching funds allocated for Nov/Dec from the Congregational Fund, which will reduce our debt down to \$1,596,266.72. We are blessed! ELIMINATION OF THIS DEBT IS BECOMING MORE AND MORE AN ATTAINABLE REALITY!
