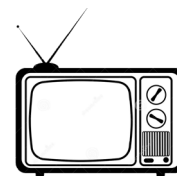

From Pastor's Desk:

Jeremiah 29:11-14 (*God's Word to the exiles in Babylon – God's Words for us as well.....*)

¹¹ I know the plans I have for you, declares the LORD, plans for welfare (peace) and not for evil, to give you a future and a hope. ¹² Then you will call upon Me and come and pray to Me, and I will hear you. ¹³ You will seek Me and find Me, when you seek Me with all your heart. ¹⁴I will restore your fortunes and gather you fromall the places where I have driven you, declares the LORD, and I will bring you back to the place from which I sent you into exile."

**Our Plans (What we believe are God's plans)
For Us Here At Peace Lutheran:**

In our Fireside Chat meetings and in many continuing conversations we have sought the counsel and advise of many as we pondered, not our will, but God's will and purpose for Peace Lutheran Church going forward.

Our Transition Task Force again reviewed and affirmed the 'five prescriptions' that came from our consultation with our Minnesota South District back in 2017.

1. Adopt a new Vision Statement (done) ***"We are a Loving Community Called by God's Grace that all Know the Peace of God"***
2. Revise its organizational structure to reflect accountable leadership (being affirmed)
3. Develop a new financial strategy to address Biblical Stewardship and debt retirement. (We have made progress as we have grown in our understanding of first fruit giving (tithes & offerings) AND have initiated a 'Debt Free in 7 Years Initiative' which expands upon 'Tell The Next Generation' which God has richly blessed these past two years. [In two years we lowered our building and remodeling debt by \$895,000, (\$690,000 in the past year)] Praise God from Whom ALL blessings flow!
4. Develop a process to improve leadership development. [Progress, need to do more!]

5. Implement strategies to improve discipleship. [Progress, need to do more!]

As we go forward here at Peace, our Transition Task Force identified Four Core Ministries:

1. Outreach to youth and young families
2. Expanded growing ministry to active and inactive members
3. Sharing the Gospel with our community targeting inactive Christians and ALL who need Jesus
4. Bible Study

I would add this note: "We need to be doing everything we can to share Jesus and His saving Gospel with our family, friends, neighbors and our community. Building upon the various activities mentioned above. Inviting and welcoming people to worship, following up on all worship, fellowship and outreach contacts, and doing everything we can to reach out to people where they are located. As we have affirmed in our mission statement each week: ***"...That All Know the Peace of God!"***

I praise God for the many of all ages who have been stepping up in worship, service, teaching, and fellowship. By the grace of God a lot of great things are happening!

I encourage everyone to prayerfully consider God's plan and desire for each of us:

- A. In regular worship attendance;
- B. In verbal support and encouragement of one another (putting the best construction on all that is said and done);
- C. (In love) deal with things and attitudes that need correction
- D. In faithful first fruit tithes and offerings;
- E. In being connected and supporting a ministry and fellowship opportunity in our congregation!

As my time begins to 'fade into the sunset' we are preparing for the calling of our next resident pastor. That pastor, likely, will watch online to see who comes for worship and he will come to

visit with us as he (and his family if he is so blessed) will prayerfully come to a decision about where God wants him to continue serving as a pastor in the Kingdom of God's Grace at this time. What will he see and hear as he watches, observes and asks questions of us and about us?

I personally think that Peace Lutheran is a great opportunity and in a great place in her history and the opportunities of service before us. For the next pastor and his family, I think that Hutchinson is a great community, close enough to the Twin Cities, but not too close! The walking trails, the lakes, boating, fishing and summer festivals and winter events are all very attractive and just part of the huge blessings of living in this area. The many resources for new and expanded ministries, our total campus, the option of living in the parsonage or a home of your choice, living in Hutch where so much that is needed is so close!

In many ways I see Peace Lutheran beginning an exciting new chapter of ministry and life-changing service for our members AND our community! That will mean that we are flexible and willing to try some new things that our new pastor may like to bring among us. If we remember that some of our old ways, practices and attitudes have not served us very well, we will be fine. The main thing will always be that that we trust and follow Jesus and His Word. We must continue to listen to one another and respect the various views of one another. Also, that we **always** love and care for one another as brothers and sisters in Christ, sharing in all things the love and compassion of Christ our Savior. And finally that we always strive to teach, live, reflect, share and uphold the truth of God's powerful and life-changing Word!

We are eager to see who our next resident pastor will be. I join in our daily prayer that he will soon be among us! May God's will be done and in His time! In the meantime, we all have work to do. The work and ministry of Jesus, a work that He has given us the privilege of

partnership, is work that is needed now. The Church, and the people desperately in need of the peace, hope and encouragement that can only be found in Jesus need us to all be doing this work, NOW!

As we see and become aware of personal and spiritual needs and concerns around us, we must act, to do otherwise is not wise or faithful!

I cannot tell you every detail of what your part must be, but I want to encourage you to prayerfully consider, pondering God's Word, what God's will is for you going forward. Then, trusting God, act accordingly.

Let's just see what God will bring about as we encourage one another and work together in mission in the days, weeks, months, years and decades to come!

I am striving to do my part, in the time that God grants me to remain as your pastor. My last Sunday with you will be sometime this year, possibly as early as June 2, possibly earlier, possibly later. My prayer is to be with you till we KNOW who the next resident pastor will be.

That's not a lot of remaining time for me here, but praise be to God, the current work and ministry of Peace Lutheran is NOT dependent on me or any future pastor, or other staff. This work and ministry given to Peace Lutheran belongs to ALL! This is the life-changing work that we have the privilege of doing NOW!

One quick note: Our next pastor will not be perfect, but that's okay, neither are we!

So thankful for the privilege of being your pastor this past 18 months!

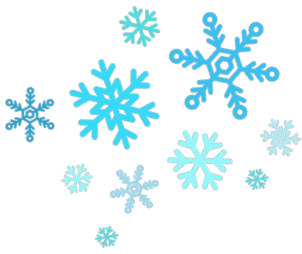

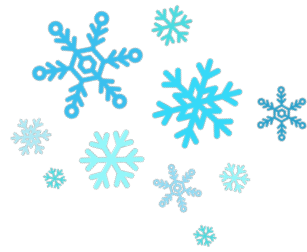


- We are asking our bakers to bring sweet treats on Friday, Feb 9.
