DEBT REDUCTION UPDATE—As you can see, our principal balance is now down to \$1,587.449.04. We recently received the \$50,000 matching funds allocated for Nov/Dec from the Congregational Fund. We will be notified in the near future if they will be able to provide any matching funds for this year. ELIMINATION OF THIS DEBT IS BECOMING A REALITY!
