From Pestor's Desk: "We are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works..." Ephesians 2:10

I have been your pastor since late July of 2022. I have served among you as your Intentional Interim Pastor for almost 20 months, longer than any other I have served. As I recently shared with our Church Council and Sunday Bible Class, we are planning on June 2 being my last Sunday. There are several details to be worked out, but it is a firm date. Our prayer is, as it has always been my prayer, that we will know the identity of our next resident pastor by that date. [We hope to be able to again extend a pastoral call soon after Easter Sunday.] With the help and work of the office of our District President, we will make certain that we have things covered during whatever time remains of our pastoral vacancy after June 2.

By God's grace, we have accomplished much in our time together. We have together helped set the table for what can be an exciting future going forward for Peace and the community of Hutch. For all the good that has taken place, to God be the glory, what great things He continues to do among and through us! May we find joy in our God-pleasing work as we continue to follow where God leads us!

There are things that I want to be sure to do before my last Sunday: seeing our shut-ins, at least one more golf round, and getting an opportunity to catch a big walleye or northern. I don't have to catch one, just want the opportunity. 😳 It may not happen as the days are full but we will do what we can!

Early in my time with you one of our young families asked me what was my favorite Bible verse. I shared Ephesians 2:8-10

"For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast. For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them."

Thanks to them I now have a metal insulated water bottle with this Bible Verse, a cross, and these words: Peace Lutheran - Hutchinson, MN - Pastor Meyer. This water bottle and a framed picture of me chomping into an apple with several children sitting in front of me for a children's message will be a couple of the cherished keepsakes for me to take with me.

The 'auf Wiedersehen's' (till we meet again, if not here than one day in heaven) are tough on me. I served at 4 churches during my first 34 years of pastoral ministry. Peace is my 6th interim church since the summer of 2015 with these last two (IL & MN) taking me away from home for much of the time. It's time for me to be home every night. Thank you for understanding!
