From Pastor's Desk:

As I am turning 68 later this year and will have completed 43 years of active, full-time pastoral ministry, I also plan to retire this summer. Sue & I will continue to live in Bennington, NE.]

God Be With You Till We Meet Again!

"I give thanks to my God always for you...", it's what pastors do for the people of the churches they have served. You always care, you always wonder how they're doing and you keep lifting them up to the Lord in prayer!

Now begins the process of saying the 'Auf Wiedersehens' ('till we meet again') that will culminate in my 'farewell' on June 2. We have all known this would be the case from the very first day. It's part of the deal in being an Intentional Interim Ministry Pastor. Knowing this doesn't make it any easier.

I appreciate the many kind comments and those who made it clear they wanted me to stay. But I assure you, it's time! My prayer is that you will be prepared to receive AND will know the identity of your next resident pastor by June 2, but we leave such things in the hands of God. We pray God's will be done, in His time!

Once we hear a pastor has accepted the call extended by our Lord through our congregation, there will be a minimum of about 8 weeks before we can install him. Plans are being put into place to make certain that our pastoral needs will continue to be addressed by a Vacancy Pastor and other pastoral assistants, during the vacancy. Watch for further news!

In the meantime, we are all God's people of faith, gifted for service. The work and ministry of God's people here at Peace will continue!

I had the privilege of getting to know some great people here at Peace! I am sorry that I did not get to know even more of you. For anything good that has happened, and there have been many good developments, to God be ALL the credit and the glory! For the things that I could have done better and for the visits and encouragements that I would have still liked to give but am now running out of time, I ask your forgiveness and understanding.

I thank you for understanding my need to spend my accumulated 'days off' and some vacation days with my wife these past almost two years. I also thank you for the kindness with which you have always treated my wife Sue during the times she has been able to visit with me here!

God has great things in mind for all of you together as you trust in the Lord and do the work God has set before you. Appreciate the gifts everyone brings, and work together in love forgiveness and respect.

As you prepare for when you welcome your new pastor I share these words from Colossians 3:

¹² Put on then, as God's chosen ones, holy and beloved, compassionate hearts, kindness, humility, meekness, and patience, ¹³ bearing with one another and, if one has a complaint against another, forgiving each other; as the Lord has forgiven you, so you also must forgive. ¹⁴ And above all these put on love, And be thankful...."
