CHILDCARE UPDATE– The Committee continues to wait for the 2024 Cost Model Report from the State, which will establish the recommended wages, benefits and rates to charge. The numbers were expected 2 months ago. Final numbers can then be calculated. As reported at the May 19th congregational meeting, an interested party has come forward who is considering the feasibility of renting the LLCC building for a daycare. With approval from the Council a tour was given, Lutheran curriculum is being reviewed etc. We are waiting to hear if there is continued interest. If so, a proposed lease would be written and 2 options presented to the Congregation.
