We've been busy cleaning and getting ready for Peace Lutheran's first monthly occasional sale, which will be held on Thurs, Oct 3rd from 9am-4pm at Peace Place. The sale will be held in the front/east rooms (Youth activities utilize the remaining rooms). Subsequent sales will be held on the first Thursday of each month.

We are looking for the following donations that are clean and gently used: lamps w/shades; pictures, jewelry; clothing; shoes; boots; purses; linens; small rugs; home décor, inc. holiday items; kitchen items; books; DVD's; CD's; records; puzzles; games; toys; crafts

NOTE: One time a year, in June, the sale will overflow into the garage area (& extend to multiple days) and include small furniture items, tools, sporting goods, gardening items, etc. These items will be accepted in May and June

DROP OFF DATES: The first two drop off dates for donations will be on Mon, Sept 9th and Mon, Sept 30th, both from 4-6pm. Volunteers will accept donations at the "flower door" on the south side of Peace Place (by the parking lot).
