# **Lighting the Advent and Christ Candles** – Broll family

We gather together this morning to celebrate the birth of God's one and only Son: Jesus, Emmanuel, Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.

Where there is despair, Jesus brings us hope—the hope of Christmas. Psalm 33:20 "We wait in hope for the LORD; he is our help and our shield." As we gather to worship: **We light the candle of HOPE.** (Light a blue candle.)

Where there is war and discord, Jesus brings us peace—the peace of Christmas. Psalm 29:11 "The Lord gives strength to His people; the Lord blesses His people with peace."

As we gather to worship: We light the candle of PEACE. (Light a blue candle.)

Where there is sorrow, Jesus brings us joy—the Joy of Christmas.

Philippians 4:4 "Rejoice in the Lord always, again I say, rejoice!"

As we gather to worship: We light the candle of JOY. (Light the pink candle.)

Where there is despair, Jesus brings us love—the love of Christmas. John 3:16 "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life." As we gather to worship: We light the candle of LOVE. (Light a blue candle.)

Where there is darkness, Jesus brings us light—the light of Christmas. John 8:12 Jesus spoke to them, saying, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life." We light the Christ Candle. As we gather to worship:

Jesus is the light of the world! (Light the Christ candle.)

# GOSPEL READING: Luke 2:8-20

The Holy Gospel according to St. Luke, the 2<sup>nd</sup> chapter. **Glory to You, O Lord.**<sup>8</sup> And in the same region there were shepherds out in the field, keeping watch over their flock by night. <sup>9</sup> And an angel of the Lord appeared to them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were filled with great fear. <sup>10</sup> And the angel said to them, "Fear not, for behold, I bring you good news of great joy that will be for all the people. <sup>11</sup> For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord. <sup>12</sup> And this will be a sign for you: you will find a baby wrapped in swaddling cloths and lying in a manger." <sup>13</sup> And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God and saying, <sup>14</sup> "Glory to God in the highest,
