One quarter of the September 4th sales, \$507.21, will go to the local Food Shelf, \$507.21 will go towards building utilities and maintenance and half, \$1,014.41, will go towards dept reduction. The next sale will be October 2nd. One quarter of the October sales will go to Safe Avenues. Donation drop off dates and times are from 4:00-6:00pm on Monday, September 22nd (the week before the sale instead of the week of the sale) at the "flower door" (south side of Peace Place—by the parking lot) where volunteers will receive donations.
